Kambaku Field Guide Training for FGASA qualifications – Field Guide Association of Southern Africa –

A vocational training cooperation of Kambaku Wildlife College CC & Kambaku Safari Lodge CC Namibia









This one year vocational training is a combination of online learning for the theory part and practical time on site for five weeks. Students will learn to identify and interpret the major living and non-living features of the natural environment in which s/he operates. According to the FGASA's standards of guiding, s/he will gain sound knowledge of the following topics:

5 WEEKS COURSE CONTENT

- ♦ guiding skills
- ♦ geology
- weather & climate
- ♦ taxonomy
- ♦ biomes, ecology & vegetation
- wild game, such as arthropods, amphibians, reptiles, fish, mammals, birds
- animal behaviour
- ♦ conservation management
- historical human habitation

Alongside the theorical learning, students will experience practical guiding during various activities such as 4x4 game drive, bush walk and game watching – giving them not only a qualification at the end of the course, but also a substantial practical working experience.

The "Apprentice Field Guide Course" offers a good basis to start your career as a "Apprentice Field Guide" or a "Apprentice Field Guide with Horse Riding*".

In order to work as a qualified field guide or field guide with horse riding*, you need more practical experience and further knowledge in the individual sub-areas. Before you start your one year course on site, you will do the online learning part for your "Apprentice Field Guide" exam (please refer to page 2).

56 WEEKS COURSE CONTENT

- ♦ 5 weeks are planned for the contents of the "Apprentice Field Guide Course" on site with the "Apprentice Field Guide Exam" as the basis of your training.
- ♦ 8 weeks to work together with your mentor guide, who will help you to put your acquired knowledge into practice and to organize your work.
- ♦ 36 weeks planned for your independent work as a apprentice field guide / apprentice riding guide.
- ♦ 1 week for participation in our courses "Kambaku Weapons Handling Theory and Practice" and "Kambaku Vehicle Maintenance and 4x4 Training".
- ♦ 1 2 weeks for assisting our tour guides as co-guide in order to discover different biomes and wildlife and to gain experience as a tour guide.
- ♦ 3 weeks reserved for self learning with the support of trainers from Kambaku Wildlife College to prepare for your Field Guide exam.

After the 56 weeks course will prepare you for the examination to be validated as a "Field Guide".

Please note, that we only have two apprenticeship training positions per year available and that the process of application for a study permit will take minimum three months.
